## Human and Physical Knowledge

### Year 6 -

- Know what causes an Earthquake
- Label the different parts of a volcano
- Know the name and locate the highest mountains

### Upper KS2

### Year 5 -

- Know what a biome is and to know the features of a biome
- Know how the rainforest is changing and why?
- Know which foods are grown locally and which are imported from overseas

### Lower KS2

### Year 4 -

- To know about the human geography of an area, including: types of settlement and land use, economic activity including trade links, and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water

### Year 2 -

- Know the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
- Know basic geographical vocabulary:
  - key **physical** features, including: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, valley, vegetation, land, sea, ocean, season and weather.
  - key **human** features, including: city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop, city, town, village.

- Know the features of the water cycle
- Know the main features of a river
- Know the physical and human features from each country in the UK
