## Hayfever

As the weather warms up, so does the pollen count – and for many children, that means the return of hayfever symptoms. Sneezing, itchy eyes, and congestion can all make it harder for children to concentrate and enjoy their day.



**We recommend that parents take a few simple steps to help children stay comfortable:**

- Start any necessary medication early: Antihistamines work best when taken regularly, especially before symptoms become severe.
- Apply a barrier balm: Dabbing a small amount of petroleum jelly around the nostrils can help trap pollen.
- Send children to school prepared: Provide tissues and a water bottle
- Check the pollen forecast and on high pollen days, keeping windows closed at home and showering after school can help reduce exposure.

If your child suffers from severe hayfever, please let the school know so we can support them as best as possible.
