

Subject Curriculum Map

Drawing

Year 6 -

- Know how to use a variety of view finders.
- Know how to import an image (scanned, retrieved, taken) into a graphics package.
- Know how to create layered images from original ideas.

Upper KS2

Year 5 -

- Know how to use wet & dry media to make different marks, lines, patterns and shapes within a drawing.
- Know how to use colour mixing and blending techniques with coloured pencils e.g. shading, hatching
- Know how to use simple perspective in their work using a single focal point and horizon.

Lower KS2

Year 4 -

- Know how to Experiment with ways in which surface detail can be added to drawings, e.g. use grades of pencil, biro, charcoal and chalk.
- Know how to make marks and lines with a wide range of drawing implements e.g. charcoal, pencil, crayon, chalk pastels, pens etc.
- Now how to create textures with a wide range of drawing implements, e.g. use oil and chalk pastel.

Year 3 -

- Know how to use different grades of pencil and other implements to draw different forms and shapes and variations in tone.
- Know how to create textures with a wide range of drawing implements
- Know that objects have a third dimension and begin to represent

Year 2 -

- Know how to use a range of media to draw
- Know how to create by drawing light/dark lines, light/dark shapes.
- Know how to draw shapes from observations.
- Know how to draw on different media

KS 1

Year 1 -

- Know how to use a variety of media to make lines: pencils, rubbers, crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal, ballpoints, chalk.
- Know how to observe and draw shapes from observations - self portrait
