Using Materials

Year 6 -

- Know how to use different grades of threads and needles.
- Know how use batik techniques.
- Know how to experiment with a range of media to overlap and layer creating interesting colours and textures and effects.

Upper KS2

Year 5 -

- Know how to use recycled, natural and man-made materials to create sculptures.
- Know how to use fabrics to create 3-D structures.

Year 4 -

- Know how to sculpt clay adequately and model a recognisable shape
- Know how to use papier-mâché to create a simple 3-D object.

Lower KS2

Year 3 -

- Know how to plan, design and make models from observation or imagination.
- Know how to construct a simple base for extending and modelling clay shapes.
- Know how to create surface patterns and textures in a malleable material.

Year 2 -

- Know how to manipulate malleable materials in a variety of ways including rolling and kneading.
- Know how to join clay when creating sculptures
- Know how to record visual information using digital cameras, video recorders.

- Know how to change the surface of a malleable material.
